The hurt will ease in time

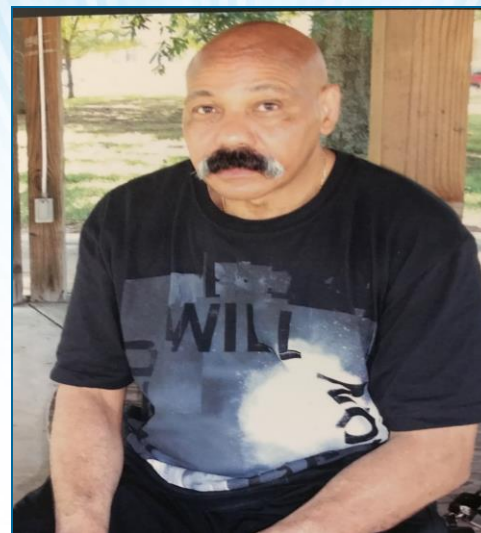
