Rebecca Lee Crumpler was the first African American woman to become a doctor. She was born February 8, 1831, and died March 9, 1895. She was married to Dr. Arthur Crumpler after the Civil War. She first practiced medicine in Boston for poor women, and children. She moved to Richmond, Virginia in 1865 only to experience intense racism. However, that did not stop her from practicing medicine.



Elizabeth "Bessie" Coleman was the first African American woman to become a pilot. She was born January 26th 1892, and died April 30th 1926. Coleman traveled the world from Chicago to France in order to finally obtain her pilot's license. Coleman eventually did get her pilot's license on June 15th 1921.



Charlotte E. Ray was the first African American woman to be a lawyer. She was born January 13th 1850, and died January 4th 1911. Ray graduated from Howard University School of Law in 1872. She became the first female to be admitted to the District of Columbia Bar. She was unable to attract many clients for being black, and a woman. She was forced to close her law office, and become a teacher instead.

These are just a few examples of the many women that succeeded even when the odds were stacked against them. Women that followed their dreams even if some of their loved ones weren't supporting them. These women paved the road for all women.


