IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT PAYMENT

It is the desire of Thompson Rose Chapel, Inc. that a family selects a funeral service that is within their means. Therefore, we do not extend credit which may create a financial hardship by overspending. Payments for services are due at the time of your arrangement conference. It is the policy of Thompson Rose Chapel to not schedule service day and time until payment has been secured. For your convenience we accept cash, checks, Visa, MasterCard, American Express and debit cards with the Visa/MasterCard symbols and verified assignable insurance policies. Use of insurance policies will require that you also pay a processing fee in the amount of 5% of the total assignment.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean that you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This general price list does not include prices for certain items that you may need or ask for such as death certificates, permits, cemetery fees, floral arrangements and newspaper notices. The prices for these items will be shown on your statement describing the goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICE FEE..... \$1500.00

Our basic services include: Conducting the arrangement conference, planning the funeral, consulting with family and clergy, temporary shelter of the remains, preparing and filing the necessary authorizations and permits, coordinating with cemetery, crematory or other third parties. In addition this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead cost, such as facility maintenance, inventory cost, insurance and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead cost will be added to the total of funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burial, and forwarding or receiving remains.

EMBALMING \$550.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary however, if you selected certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you pay for it, such as direct cremation of immediate burial.

REFRIDGERATIONPER DAY \$75.00

California Law requires refrigeration of all unembalmed bodies held beyond a 24 hour period. In addition it is the policy of Thompson Rose Chapel to charge for refrigeration of all remains to be held beyond 3 days without disposition arrangements, and all remains held beyond a 7 day period.

All transportation charges are based on a 40 mile radius, beyond this radius, additional fees will be charged at \$3.00 per mile. Additional fees apply to limousine service beyond 4 hours at the rate of \$100.00 per hour.

FORWARDING REMAINS***\$1825.00***

This selection includes applicable professional services, basic overhead, transfer of remains to funeral home, embalming, temporary shelter of remains, and transfer to local airport (40 mile radius) **This fee does not include** dressing and casketing, any visitation, services, shipping containers or other items you may need or desire.

RECEIVING REMAINS***\$1350.00***

This selection includes applicable professional services, basic overhead, transfer of remains to funeral home, temporary shelter of remains, and transportation to local cemetery (40 mile radius). **This fee does not include** any visitation, services, additional transportation fees, dressing, casketing or other items you may need or desire.

GRAVESIDE SERVICE***\$1875.00***

This selection includes basic services of the funeral director, staff and equipment; a proportionate share of the overhead cost, transfer of remains to the funeral home, temporary shelter of the remains, and transportation to local cemetery (40 mile radius). This fee does not include embalming, dressing and casketing, casket, tax on casket, visitation, services, cemetery fees or other items you may need

or desire. **If you desire additional items such as visitation or services graveside fee is not applicable, your contract for goods and services will be itemized.**

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

This selection includes basic services of the funeral director, staff and equipment; a proportionate share of the overhead cost, transfer of remains to the funeral home, temporary shelter of the remains, and transportation to local cemetery. This fee does not include embalming, visitation, or other items you may desire.

- A. Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser \$2075.00
- B. Immediate burial with alternative container \$2275.00
- C. Immediate burial with minimum cloth covered wood casket..... \$2875.00

DIRECT CREMATION

Our charge for direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of the overhead cost, transfer of the remains to the funeral home, transportation to crematory, cremation container and cremation fee. **There is no viewing of any type with direct cremation.** (Please see our service with cremation package if viewing is desired).

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we regularly offer for sale are fiberboard (cardboard) containers.
