She attended Virginia University of Lynchburg, Virginia and received her Ministerial Certificate on May 10, 2003. She received her Certificate of License to preach the Gospel Ministry from Mt. Ruth preached the gospel in season, out of season, and according to her and what we've heard and or witnessed her do, was to preach the *Roman Road* to many of the men who frequented Daddy's spot under the big oak tree and would come running to her begging to be saved before they died. Our mother was the strongest and most determined person we knew. She was a warrior on all sorts of levels, even in death. The night before she died, we witnessed her ministering to the angels or someone in her room. She'd had a very restless night and day and could not be comforted. We could only hear the compassion and softness in her voice; it was so gentle and reassuring. We wanted to go in to see who it or they were, but were advised her against it because it was not meant for us to hear or to understand. Ruth met with God a short time after that around 11p.m. Though it saddened her, she let Sandra know she would not be here to celebrate her birthday with her in December.
